PSG III / OSG III, student show, January 21- February 7

Deadline for proposals Wednesday, **November 13, 3PM**

(Install January 15-20)

PSG IV/ OSG IV student show February 17 - March 6

Deadline for proposals Wednesday, **January 22, 3PM.**

(Install February 10-14)

PSG V/ OSG V student show March 23 - April 10

Deadline for proposals Wednesday, **February 12, 3PM.**

(Install March 16-20)

PSG VI/ OSG VI student show April 20 – May 9

Deadline for proposals Wednesday, **March 4, 3PM.**

(Install April 13-17)

Proposals may be for individuals or groups. A written printed proposal with the signature of your selected art faculty advisor must be submitted to the Gallery Director on or before the deadline. Include which gallery you want to display in, PSG or OSG (lobby), proposals must include name, phone number, email address of all participants. Include show title, description, and date for proposed show. At least 20 examples of anticipated exhibition works in digital form or equivalent supporting material. **Visual materials must include medium and sizes of artwork.** All proposals must be printed out on paper. Include a digital copy of the proposal with images (usb thumb drive). Incomplete proposals will not be considered.

Submit proposals/review: Deadlines noted above. Submit proposals to Tim Sheesley, Gallery Director, Room 160 FA, (436-2445). The Gallery Director and the Gallery Advisory Committee will review and accept proposals.

Project Space Gallery will be open from 11am-5pm M-F when school is in session. It may also be opened for special evening events. Exhibitor will be responsible for designing their own promotional materials consisting of a poster and hand out cards. Students will be responsible for installing and removing their shows. The gallery staff will be available for assistance. Student artwork will not be insured. The college, art department, gallery director, and faculty sponsor are not responsible for any damage or loss of artwork. Submission of a proposal constitutes agreement with these terms.
